AU303 is a toy AudioUnit, that acts like a cheap TB303.

It can run in two modes :

- expander mode :

AU303 acts like a normal synth, responding to MIDI notes.

- pattern mode :

You've got 16 patterns, each having 16 steps and can change the note and velocity for each step.

You can also change the resonance, cutoff and decay of the filter.

The rythm is automatically synchronized to the host, if the host provides timing informations.

You can use C5 to D#6 to switch pattern.

Other notes transpose the current pattern, which is defined for C3

To install, copy AU303.component to the /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components folder or to the ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components folder.
