

Log Cabin Siding

Log homes today range from factory prepared kits to site-hewn timbers, with walls from 6 to 15 inches thick. Thick log walls provide substantial insulation, along with the rustic look.

Many systems interlock to form a weatherproof seal. Some systems merely look like logs, but are really thick siding applied over a traditional stud-framed wall. Styles of log homes vary among the manufacturers and most offer custom designs.
