

Small space landscaping is a snap if you do a little planning first. Use dwarf and miniature plants that won't get too big or grow too fast. Dwarf varieties of boxwoods, camellias, daisies, and roses can be planted in corners, containers or along structures. Add trellises to vertical surfaces for climbing plants next to the house or garage. Grass adds a nice frame around your patio or house, and mowing it takes no time at all. For those little empty spots, tuck in iris, crocus and tulip bulbs. Set pots or containers on patios, decks, and lawns to extend your landscape.
