F6 Play A credit

F7 Insert Max bet(5 credits, if you have any credits that is...)

F9 Insert a coin

F10 Deal cards

ALT-F10 Exit (display stats) press mousebutton to exit

HELP Display current stats: money won or lost.

Set the icon's tool type to "VALUE=5" for nickels, "VALUE=25" for quarters, and "VALUE=100" for dollars. Other settings are NOT recommended.

When run from the CLI, or no tool type is set, VALUE defaults to 5(nickels).
