

Poker Solitaire for Windows Shareware Edition

How to Play

To start Poker Solitaire or *Pokersol*, just select "Start a New Game" from the "Games" menu or click on the card deck in the upper left corner of the game window. This will shuffle the card deck and show you the first card you can play.

You move the cards by clicking the mouse on the spot where you want the card to go.

You play Poker Solitaire by building ten Poker hands -- five across and five down --to achieve the highest possible scores.

Pokersol Scoring

PokerSol scoring is based on the relative ranking of hands in the game of Poker.

One hundred and fifty points is considered a win.

Score Hand

- 100 Royal Flush
 - 75 Straight Flush
 - 50 Four of a Kind
 - 25 Full House
 - 20 Flush
 - 15 Straight
 - 10 Three of a Kind
 - 5 Two Pairs
 - 2 One Pair

The "Game" Menu

Start a New Game"

Starts a new game.

"Undo last move"

Undoes the last move by removing the card you just played and returns it to the top of the deck so you can replay the card.

"View High Scores"

Displays the five highest pokersol scores

"Quit"

Exit the program

"About Pokersol"

Displays the program "About" information screen.

The "Options" Menu

"Play Regular Game"

You play all twenty-five cards down one at a time.

"Throw down a few cards first"

Plays up to five cards before letting you start.

"Use Larger Cards"

If you are using Windows at a screen resolution of 800 by 600 or better, then this option uses larger cards, making it a little easier to see on small monitors. This option is disabled for lower resolution screens.

"Use Alternate Colors"

Selects a grey and white color scheme for PokerSol.

"Reset High Scores"

The menu choice resets all the high scores for pokersol.

The "Help" Menu

Displays this help file.
