How to play Solitaire...

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General rules of the game

The goal of this game of solitaire is very simple: Get all the cards to the top four play piles piles. Sounds easy right? Cards are played from low to high in alternating colors on the upper 4 play piles starting with a random card and high to low in alternating colors on the lower play fields.

Cans and Can'ts

Cans

You can play cards from anywhere on the upper four play piles You can play cards from the discard pile to the cards on the lower play fields. You can play cards to blank spots in the lower play fields. The cards go full circle: Aces are played on Kings in the upper play piles and Kings on Aces on the lower play fields.

Can'ts

You can't play cards from the center pile to the cards on the lower play fields.

You can't go through the deck more than once.

You can't back up---maybe in a future release.

You can't remove cards from the upper play piles.

You can't play cards from the discard pile to the center pile.

Stacks of multiple cards on the lower play fields cannot be moved and cards can only be played from them to the upper play piles not to each other.

New Game Starts a new game, shuffles deck and clears playing table.

New Color Lets you change the color of the playing table.

Default Color Changes the playing table back to the default green
