### SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 4. Type **D:\setup.exe** (substitute **D** with the correct drive letter of your CD-ROM drive if necessary)
- 5. FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS THAT APPEAR ON THE SCREEN

The **full** installation process will take up approximately 10 megs of hard disk space. Installing the full install gives you additional speed and it also allows you to save certain activities, such as keeping a record of the test scores etc.

### LAUNCHING FROM THE PROGRAM GROUP

Once the Install process has been successfuly completed, you may start the tutorial by double-clicking on the **LearnKey Windows 3.1** icon.

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN YOUR TRAINING

May we suggest that you select the "HELP" button from the directory page and learn about the powerful features of **LearnKey Windows 3.1 CD-ROM**.

# USING THE INTERACT BUTTON

During the instruction, you may want to interact with that section of the corresponding software. For example, by selecting the **Interact** button a list of exercises will appear. When an lesson is selected, you will actually launch that exercise from within **Windows 3.1**. To return to your CD-ROM instruction simply close **Windows 3.1** and if needed click on the LearnKey icon. You may toggle between **Windows 3.1** and the CD-ROM by pressing and holding the ALT key and pressing the TAB key.

## COLOR DRIVER RECOMMENDATION

We recommend that you have your 256 color driver loaded before beginning your **LearnKey**, **Windows 3.1** CD-ROM. A high color driver may interfere with the speed of the program, and anything less than 256 colors will result in a color change that will greatly affect the look of the program. You may change your color driver by opening the Main group from within the Program

manager and then select Windows Setup.
