## **1. Applications in this release**

The following components are included in Mosaic for ZDNet:

## **2. New features in this release**

=====

### **SPRY Mosaic**

- \* The 32 bit version of SPRY Mosaic supports Windows 95's faster 32 bit data transfer capabilities, significantly speeding up access and viewing of World Wide Web documents.
- \* Supports Secure-Hypertext Transfer Protocol (S-HTTP) for the secure transmission of corporate data such as credit card numbers, accounting records, human resource files, and other mission-critical corporate information. SPRY Mosaic allows secure connections with any server based on S-HTTP. For more information on security and Mosaic, see the online help.
- \* Includes the CompuServe Wallet, which provides secure financial transactions with an ever-increasing number of merchants.
- \* Clicking on the right mouse button produces a menu of frequently used options.
- \* Includes an in-depth tutorial on using Mosaic.
- \* Includes extensively updated online help.

### **SPRY Mail**

- \* Supports MIME for attaching and receiving binary files, like word processing and graphics files.
- \* Includes a spell checker that uses the dictionaries from Microsoft Word or Microsoft Office.
- \* Return receipt feature allows you to receive acknowledgement that your mail message has been received.
- \* Can automatically save copies of messages you've sent.
- \* Several methods of message notification are available.

### **SPRY Dialer**

- \* Now includes support for multiple dialer profiles, allowing you to store several different Dialer configurations.

## **3. Installation & application notes**

### **Mosaic**

Tables are not supported in this version of Mosaic, but will be supported in a future version.

Drag and drop procedures to the desktop are not supported in this version.

The visited links feature only shows visited links for HTML pages. Gopher, FTP, mailto, and other non-HTML links will not appear as having been visited.

The WinCIM option in the Tools menu is not compatible with WinCIM 1.4. This option will function if a copy of WinCIM 2.0 is present on your system. WinCIM 2.0 is to be released by early Fall 1995 and will be available from CompuServe.

If you are upgrading to Mosaic for ZDNet, you may see the message "The Hotlist you selected is already loaded." This will only happen the first time you open Mosaic; click OK, and Mosaic will open successfully. After the first launch, Mosaic will open without producing this error message.

In the 16 bit version of Mosaic, the Quick menu and the Hyperlink menu's "Create Shortcut" option is dimmed. This is a feature of the Windows 95 operating system and is not supported by Windows 3.1 or Windows for Workgroups.

### **SPRY Mail**

Long file names are not supported in SPRY Mail. You will need to use the standard DOS format (eight or fewer characters followed by a period and a three character extension: **filename.ext**).

SPRY Mail will regularly synchronize your mail folders. Depending on the size of your folders and the number of mail messages you have, this may take some time to complete; please be patient and allow the folder synchronization to complete.

SPRY Mail, when receiving messages with attachments, will attempt to display the attachments as icons in the Mail attachment window. Depending on the mailer the message was sent from, some attachments may not be displayed as icons, but will display as "garbage" text in the body of the message. You can read these attachments by saving the messages to files and using the appropriate utility program to decode them.

### **CompuServe Wallet**

You may experience difficulty connecting to the CyberCash Wallet server while making online purchases. Although this will hinder your transaction, it will not jeopardize your security.

### **WinCIM**

An upgrade for WinCIM (WinCIM 2.0) will be available in early Fall 1995. Upgrades can be requested from CompuServe. Please do not contact SPRY or Mosaic technical support regarding the WinCIM upgrade.

### **MBOX95.HLP**

If you're running Windows NT 3.5, the Mosaic In A Box Help icon displayed in the Program Manager will not work. You can open the .HLP files for each SPRY application from the application or by clicking the help file names in the File Manager. The Help file runs properly from Windows NT 3.51, and Windows 3.x.
