Introduction

This contains samples of the <u>Bar/Area/Line graph object</u> displayed in different ways. This is by no means a definitive list of all the combinations that this graph object has, it is only a few suggestions. The samples are one layer 0 to 2.

Layer 0

This layer contains examples of mostly bar graphs with various styles, overlaps and fills.

Layer 1

This layer contains examples of area graphs (and some combinations), Notice that, just as bars can be filled with a picture, so can area graphs.

Layer 2

This layer is mostly line-graphs and marker graphs.

Viewing a Layer

You may prefer to reduce the scaling until all the graphs are visible at the same time.

- Set the Layer to be viewed
- Select <u>Scale</u> on the Settings Menu
- Select Scale to Fit.

Copy a Graph

To use one of these graphs as a base for your own graph.

- Switch to Edit Mode
- Select the Graph Object to Copy
- Select Copy on the Edit Menu
- The whole object is copied
- Switch to your own worksheet
- Select Paste
- Move the object to where you want it and pipe it in.
