# **Program Operation**

Jiffy Viewer's concept and operation is very simple. Just use the file browsing controls to select a graphic image to view, then press <Enter> or double-click the file name to view it. With Jiffy Viewer you may view files one at a time, or automatically in slide-show fashion.

#### **Menu Commands**

Jiffy Viewer has several operations accessible with a pull down menu or by pressing a hotkey combination. The pull down menus are located right underneath the title bar in the main program window. Access the pull down menu by clicking on a menu name with the mouse or by pressing and holding the Alt key and tapping the underlined letter in a menu name. Execute an option by clicking on it with the mouse or by using the arrow keys to highlight an operation and press Enter.

### **Registration Information**

Jiffy Viewer is marketed as shareware. It is not free. You may use Jiffy Viewer on your system for a period of 30 days to determine if this is the viewer for you. When you decide it is, register your copy to obtain:

Jiffy Viewer is \$15 (in US funds), plus \$1.25 shipping for domestic orders or \$2.50 for overseas orders. Residents of Kentucky must add 6% state sales tax. ### **Print Command**

Jiffy Viewer can print the image on the screen to the default Windows printer. Invoke this command to start the printing process by selecting it from the menu or by pressing Ctrl-P. The image on the screen is printed on the printer.

Please note this command is disabled when the screen is clear and during slide show operation.

### **Print Options**

The Print Options dialog box provides you with some flexibility when printing images to a printer. The options provided are:

#### **Print File Name**

When selected, this option prints the image name at the top of the printed page.

#### **Print Resolution**

When selected, this option prints the image's size and number of colors at the top of the printed page.

#### Scale to Fit Page

When selected, this option scales the image as large as what fits on the current printer page considering page orientation and image size. Unscaled images are printed at the printer resolution.

After selecting the options you desire, click the OK button. The dialog disappears and the settings are saved to JIFFY.INI in your Windows directory. Clicking on Cancel leaves the settings as selected, but does not write the changes to disk.

### **Printer SetUp**

This dialog presents configuration options for printers installed on your system. Changing the settings in this dialog changes your default settings for every application in Windows! Please make sure to reverse any changes you may make after exiting the program to so as not to affect other applications that may be using the printer.

# **Exit Program**

This command exits the program. You may also exit the program by pressing Esc, or by selecting Close from the application control menu or from Task Manager.

### **Clear Screen Command**

This command clears the contents of the display area. You may press Ctrl-C as a short cut key for this command. Clearing the screen disables the <u>Print Image</u>, <u>Image</u> <u>Information</u>, and <u>Hide Controls</u> commands.

### **Image Information Command**

This command presents a dialog box containing the displayed image's name, dimensions, and number of colors. You may press Ctrl-l as a short cut key for this command. This command is disabled if the display area is clear.

### **Hide Controls Command**

This command removes the file browsing controls from the screen and redisplays the image full window. You may press Ctrl-Z as a short cut key for this command. When you are finished looking at the full image, press a key or click the mouse to redisplay the file controls.

### **Slide Show Command**

This command allows you to view multiple image files from a directory in full window mode with little or no intervention on your part. When started, this command pops up a dialog box to set up the slide show.

On the left side of the dialog box is a list of image files in the current directory. Use the mouse or keyboard to highlight one or more files to view. You can click on the Mark All button to highlight every file, and the Unmark All to remove every file from the selection queue.

At the top of the right side of the dialog is a spin button used to select the interval between slides. Click on the up or down spin indicators to select a time out interval. Clicking on the Save button saves the interval you selected to JIFFY.INI (located in your Windows directory). You may select an interval ranging from 3 seconds to 999 seconds. NOTE: The shareware version limits the upper time limit to 20 seconds.

Click on the OK button to start the slide show. The program hides the controls, then shows the files you selected one by one in full window mode. Slides continue until all highlighted files have been displayed. After the last file is displayed, the controls reappear on the screen.

You have several options while the slide show is in progress:

Pressing a key or clicking on the image bypasses the time out interval and immediately moves on to the next image.

Pressing the space bar pauses the slide show at the current slide. Press any key or click on the image to restart the show.

Pressing Esc cancels the rest of the slide show and returns the program to regular operation.

As each image is displayed, it is deselected in the slide show dialog box. This way, if you need to stop the slide show before it is finished, you can return to it to finish viewing the remaining images. The remaining selections are cleared should you change directories.

This command provides a search window so you may look for help using keywords.
