PrClip is distributed Free and As Is. The program was written to serve the needs of myself and a few co-workers. It appears to work fine with Windows 3.1 and Windows for Workgroups 3.1. Any comments can be addressed to the Compuserve ID above.

PrClip is a program designed to provide an easy way of doing screen prints. Once the data is on the clipboard a double click on the PrClip Icon will send your clipboard data to the active Window's printer. PrClip was designed for Screen Prints, but Text on the clipborad can be printed, too. To put data on the clipboard use the [Print Screen] or [Alt] - [Print Screen] as documented in the Microsoft Windows Manual.

SETUP: Copy PRCLIP.EXE and PRCLIP.WRI to the directory of choice.

Copy VBRUN300.DLL to the WINDOWS\SYSTEM directory. If you obtained PrClip from a BBS you will also need to aquire a copy of VBRUN300.DLL (if it not already on system).

Create an Icon in the Windows Group of your choice with the parameter RES or ONE.

USAGE: Once setup is complete, the program will operate in the following manner:

PRCLIP.EXE Displays on-screen instruction on the two options below. Offers user a chance to print the contents of the clipboard then

PRCLIP.EXE ONE Prints the contents of the clipboard then terminates.

PRCLIP.EXE RES Programs begins minimized. A Double Click will cause the print of the clipboard. Once complete the program will Minimize itself for more requests. To Exit, Click on the Icon & choose 'Close'.
