Credit Card Plus 1.0 for Windows

Introduction:

Credit Card Plus 1.0 for Windows is a very simple to use credit card database. You can keep track of:

- (1) Account information (account numbers, interest rates, credit limits, etc.),
- (2) Bank information (names, addresses, phone numbers, etc.), and
- (3) Monthly statement information (payments, purchase, advances, etc.).

This application provides an easy way of displaying all your information with just a click of the mouse. You can display your information in detail (items purchased, places items were purchased, amount for every purchase, place of advances, etc.), or you can display it on a monthly or yearly basis for each individual credit card (total payments, purchases, advances, and interest paid).

There's basically not that much calculations done by this application except for the credit available and the totals of payments, purchases, advances and interest paid. The reason for this is that every other calculation is a function of the interest charged by the bank issueing the credit card. And that interest charge depends on when the bank receives the payments. To put it short, interest charges depend on how fast the mail travels (which is how most of us pay credit card payments) and this is not a constant. And so any calculation depending on the interest charge can not be possible.

Installation:

The installation files for this application have been removed in order to keep the downloading time to a minimum. You will receive a fully installable application if you register for it. To install Credit Card Plus, just follow the next few procedures.

- 1. Create a subdirectory for this application.
- Copy CCPLUS10.EXE, CCPLUS10.WRI, REGISTER.TXT, and CCPLUS10.HLP into this subdirectory.
- 3. Move the files COMMDLG.DLL, CMDIALOG.VBX, and GRID.VBX into your Windows\System directory. If some of these files already exist them keep the recent ones and discard the others.
- 4. Execute CCPLUS10.EXE

Note: This application requires VBRUN300.DLL which is available at many cites.

Getting Started

The first thing you should do is to create a New File. Then start adding credit card information of all your credit cards. You should have all of your credit cards and a monthly statement (preferably the latest one) on hand for each card available when you do this. After you have entered all the

information for all your card then you are ready to enter monthly data from your monthly statements.

Entering Monthly Data

- 1. Choose the credit card you want to enter data into.
- 2. Choose month and year.
- 3. Make sure the 'Add' option is selected.
- 4. Start entering payments, purchases, and advances by selecting the appropriate icons.

To edit the Interest Paid or the Balance, double click on the 'Interest/Balance' frame.

Editing/Deleting Information

To edit or delete payments, purchases, and/or advances from the main windows choose 'Edit...Monthly statement' from the 'Credit Card' menu. Or click on the dollar sign icon.

Editing:

choose the 'Edit' options and double-click on the appropriate item you want to edit (payment, purchase, or advance).

Deleting:

choose the 'Delete' option and double-click on the appropriate item.

Note:

When editing or deleting, the payment, purchase, and advance icons will be disabled.

Displaying Your Information

You can display:

- 1. Monthly statements for all your credit cards by selecting 'Monthly Statements' from the Display drop-down list.
- 2. Yearly information for payments, purchases, advances, and interest paid by selecting 'Yearly Information' from the Display drop-down list.
- 3. Detailed information on payments, purchases, and advances by selecting the appropriate item from the Display drop-down list.

<u>Menu Items</u>

File:

New	Create a new file.
Open	Open an existing file.
Save	Save your file.
Exit	Exit Credit Card Plus.

Credit Card:

Add	Add a new credit card to the database.
Delete	Delete a credit card from the database.
EditAccount	Edit account information.
EditBank	Edit bank information.
EditMonthly Statements	Go into the 'Monthly Statement' window.

Help:

Contents	Open the Help file.
Search	Search help for a particular subject.
About	Author information.
Register	How to register CCPlus.
