

# CRLF - A Unix to DOS Utility

**Function:**

CRLF converts Unix style text files to DOS standard text files.

**Installation**

Copy CRLF.EXE to any directory you wish, launch it using Program Manager or your favorite menu system.

**Constraints**

Requires Windows 3.1. Reads any length file, supports records up to 998 character in length.

**Using CRLF**

Select the File/Open menu command, choose the input file using the standard file selection box. Then choose the output file with a second file selection dialog box. The file names **must** be different.

CRLF does a prepass of the file to count the records, and then does the conversion. A progress meter is displayed to help pass the time.

**Disclaimer**

You use CRLF entirely at your own risk. It may or may not be suitable for your system.
