## What is VB Run v1.0

In short, VB Run is a utility that issues the File/Save Project and Run command in VisualBasic 3.0 for Windows programming environment. Although VisualBasic 3.0 has an option to allow the programmer to save his/her project before running it in the VIsualBasic environment, I still found myself using the File/Save Project and Run command sequence.

# Caveats

The following are some limitations/caveats that I feel the user should be aware of:

• **VB Run v1.0** checks the window text (i.e, caption) of VisualBasic 3.0 for Windows to determine whether the environment is in design mode or run mode. Since there are utilities that my change this window text at some time interval, **VB Run v1.0** may not be able to determine the current environment mode and will issue a warning message accordingly.

• **VB** Run v1.0 was written and tested using VisualBasic 3.0 for Windows. I havent tried running this on earlier version of VisualBasic. If you find it will work on earlier versions, please let the author know. The author can be reached by email at grtorlba@seattleu.edu.

#### Accessing the Pop Up Menu

To access the menu of **VB Run v1.0**, click on the right mouse button.

#### Moving VB Run v1.0 Around the Screen

To move **VB Run v1.0** around the screen, click and hold down the left mouse button on the area outside the Run button.

#### Quitting VB Run v1.0

To quit **VB Run v1.0**, choose the Exit command from the pop-up menu.

#### Save Project

If checked, **VB Run v1.0** will send the File/Save Project command before sending the Run command.

#### Always On Top

If checked, **VB Run v1.0** will remain on top of any window on the desktop.

#### Open If Minimized

If checked and VisualBasic is minimized, **VB Run v1.0** will restore the VisualBasic desktop. If the VisualBasic desktop is minimized, **VB Run v1.0** will not send any commands to VisualBasic. Exit Exits VB Run v1.0.
