BEFORE YOU START:

Add the following line to the [Microsoft Word 2.0] section of your Window's WIN.INI file:

LoadToolbarBitmaps=yes

<u>These icons are designed for a VGA VIDEO DISPLAY:</u> Note: V means VGA, size 468 x 16, 256 colors.

First, change to your winword directory, usually C:\winword:

C:\>cd\winword

Second, make a directory inside your winword directory called tbackup, which stands for toolbar backup:

C:\WINWORD>md\winword\tbackup

Third, move or copy your BMP files entitled: v1tbar.bmp, v2tbar.bmp, v3tbar.bmp, v4tbar.bmp from your c:\winword directory to your c:\winword\tbackup directory: IF YOU DON'T DO THIS, YOU MAY LOSE YOUR ORIGINAL TOOLBAR ICONS!!!

C:\WINWORD>move v*.bmp c:\winword\tbackup

C:\WINWORD>copy v*.bmp c:\winword\tbackup
C:\WINWORD>del v*.bmp
this will move ALL of the above mentioned file names to c:\winword\tbackup.

Next, move or copy all of my files, V1tbar.bmp, V2tbar.bmp, V3tbar.bmp, V4tbar.bmp to your winword directory.

C:\DIRECTORY>move v*.bmp c:\winword

or

C:\DIRECTORY>copy v*.bmp c:\winword

Directory being the directory which contains my files, usually the download directory.

Finally start Microsoft Word for Windows 2.0 and see if the changes have taken effect, if they haven't, exit back out to DOS, delete my BMP files, change to the tbackup directory (subdirectory of the winword directory), move or copy those files back into your main winword directory (usually C:\winword) and remove the directory c:\winword\tbackup, or use the deltree command.

If an irreversible error should arise, try using the undelete command, if your DOS version has it, or use the Microsoft Word for Windows 2.0 installation disks.
