SHAREWARE LICENSE TERMS

The Winston Installer utility is NOT public domain or free software, but is being distributed as SHAREWARE. This means that if you are a regular user of Winston Installer you should register and receive the enhanced version as a bonus. Only from the income from your registrations can the authors continue to provide product support, make enhancements and basically stay in business.

Non-registered users of this software are granted a limited license to make an evaluation copy for the trial use on a private, non-commercial basis, for the purpose of determining if Winston Installer is suitable. At the end of this trial period, the user should either register his or her copy or discontinue use.

Registered users of Winston Installer may use Winston Installer on any computer as long as there is no chance of the same copy being run on multiple computers at the same time.

Operators of BBS'S are encouraged to post Winston Installer and other material by DSI, for downloading by their users.

This license to use Winston Installer does NOT include the right to distribute or sell Winston Installer. These terms follow.

DISTRIBUTION OF Winston Installer BY VENDORS AND COMPUTER DEALERS

Distributors of "public domain" or user supported software libraries must obtain written permission to distribute Winston Installer and related material. No one may use Winston Installer as a promotion for any commercial venture or as an enticement for the user to pay for any program, product, or service unless they have RECEIVED the express written permission of the programs author.

In order to distribute Winston Installer the dealer must comply with the following conditions:

- 1.) You must obtain written permission from DSI to distribute Winston Installer. If you receive no reply, write again: or silence does not constitute permission, and you may not distribute pending receipt of permission.
- 2.) A fee no greater than \$10.00 may be charged for each disk sold. Winston Installer may not be included on any disk sold for more than \$10.00, including CD-ROM or optical disks, w/o express written permission from

DSI.

- 3.) Vendors may not modify or delete any files on the disk. Vendors may add a "GO" or any other reasonable text file to assist the user. These files added by the vendor must be easily identifiable and end users must be allowed to delete the added files.
- 4.) Vendors must make a reasonable effort to distribute only the most recent versions of Winston Installer. All vendors who have requested and received written permission to distribute Winston Installer will be notified of updates as they are released.

DSI disclaims all warranties relating to this software, whether expressed or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, and all such warranties are expressly and specifically disclaimed. In no event shall DSI liability for any damages ever exceed the price paid for the license to use the software, regardless of the form of claim. Title=text

Title of this disk; displayed in installation screen and asked for when a new disk is needed.

Path

Optional default path override. Use "-" to keep default path.

Run

0 or 1; Runs the program. Useful for displaying README.TXT or running your program to do initialization. EXE files are passed "!" as a parameter.

PM Install

0 or 1; Install this program in Program Manager.

WinDir Copy

0 or 1; Put this file in Windows' directory.

SysDir Copy

0 or 1; Put this file in Windows' System directory.

Make changes to WIN.INI here. Format is:

entryx=key,value,restart (1|0)

[SYSTEM.INI]

Make changes to SYSTEM.INI here. Format is:

entryx=key,value,restart (1|0)

Naming of the program

You are free to change the name of Winston Installer to best suit your needs. The
INI file must be named the same as the install program.

If you decide to call it "MYINST.EXE" then the INI must be "MYINST.INI"
