Footer and/or header page numbering in alternating page format is optionally available, via user selection of a checkbox, in the dialog box initially displayed upon running the macro. The user may print odd pages only, even pages only, or both odd and even pages. Additionally, an option is provided to print a selected range of pages from the odd or even pages of a document.

a result of editing/altering the document. By using the "odd page print" with a selected page range and then the "even page print" option with a corresponding requested page range, a central portion of a lengthy document can be reprinted without the need to reprint the entire document. I find this feature particularly handy when a minor modification of a page or two in the middle of a document is necessitated. Of course, the total length of the document must be unchanged after editing for the newly printed pages to "fit" into the original printout of the entire document. Inserting a page break before and after the changed areas can preserve the page breaks if a single page in the middle of the document is edited and changed and a printout of the single page is desired.

the mouse cursor over the minimized icon of Winword and double clicking. Printing can be halted then by pressing the "Esc" key at least twice. Note that the print manager will continue to print because the pages of the document are added to the print queue one at time. Therefore, to halt the printing of the documents in the print manager queue, you must switch to the print manager and "exit" the print manager to halt further printing.

convenient access to the macro. Automatic installation of the macro via double clicking in the box above does not install the macro into any of the pull down menus since some people, myself included, do not like modifications to the "basic" operation or appearance of their software.

## **Important Instructions:**

FilePrinterSetup.Printer= "Epson LQ-570 Scalable Font On LPT1:"

to include the description that Windows uses for your specific printer. To obtain the printer description for your printer click on "File/Printer Setup" to view the available options. Note that each printer description line includes a ":" at the end of the line, and the colon MUST be included in the "FilePrinterSetup.Printer" command line. For example, if you have an HP Laserjet II Printer, the line should be modified to read:

Another location to obtain the printer description from is the Control Panel for Windows in the "Main" group of icons of Program Manager. Activate the Control Panel and then the Printers icon to view the installed printers.

2. Perform a "File/SaveAll" from the "File" menu to save the changes you made in step 1. Answer "yes" to all inquiries during the "File/Save All" process to save the macro in your globally available macro set.

"Macro/Edit" menu command to edit "PrintSpecial" and execute an "Edit/Replace" command while viewing the macro window. The macro as delivered uses the Arial font and one need only substitute "Times Roman" for "Arial" at all places in the macro to change the default font used to insert the page numbering in the footer and header. After making the font change, perform a "File/Save all" command and answer yes to both dialog box inquiries to save the macro changes.

upon closing the document when you are prompted as to whether you want to save the "global and command" changes. Alternatively, you can "delete" the macro using the "Macro/Edit" file menu command by selecting the macro and the "delete" option.
