The Fate Line

The line of Saturn is also known as the **fate** line or line of life task. It shows the degree to which we are fulfilling our goals in life. The stronger and clearer the fate line the more content we are with the direction of our life. Ideally, it should start at the wrist and ends in the mount of the Saturn. The further up on the hand the fate line begins, the later in life the person finds his life's work. Absent or weak Saturn line reveals lack of focus in life or inability to accomplish goals.

Beginning Patterns:



The fate line beginning **inside** the life line tells that an individual has difficulty to establish oneself in a career. This may be due to pressure or expectations from parents. The person's independence might be sacrificed due to care of an elderly or sick relative. A strong sense of duty acquired in early years will prevail



When a fate line starts in the **center of the wrist** an individual is independent by nature. People with the Saturn line starting at this perfect point, set their own goals without authority of someone else and pursue them voluntarily.



When a fate line starts **in the mount of Luna** the person's life path will vary with potential for several careers and frequent relocation. The career decisions do not originate from family circle but rather are influenced by friends, teachers, television or books.

Ending Patterns:



A fate line **ending before the head line** indicates that an individual made most of the life efforts before the age of 30. It also suggests that a serious misjudgment has been made which cut short what might have been a promising career.



A fate line **ending at the head line** is found on hands of people which are well-established at the age of 30. However, it might also indicate end of a person's career due to loss of credibility.



A fate line **ending between the head line and the line of heart** pinpoints thirty-something as a period of lifetime accomplishment.



A fate line **ending at the heart line** is found on hands of people which are well-established at the age of 40. It could also imply an emotional blunder such as a public scandal, causing loss of credibility and terminating one's career.



A fate line **ending after the heart line** shows a long career path. An individual will remain active even in retirement age. When a fate line ends between Saturn mount and Apollo mount a fame and popularity will be achieved. A person likely chooses a career in arts.



A fate line ending after the heart line shows a long career path. An individual will remain active even in retirement age. When a fate line **ends in the Jupiter mount** the career involves leadership or holding a public office.



If a fate line **doubles or triples at the end**, an individual will have at retirement age all necessary resources and energy to go ahead with all exciting plans already sitting at back-burner. It could be traveling to exotic locations, artistic endeavors or interest in politics or religion.



Bars and islands at the end of a fate line foretell difficult times at retirement age due to financial restriction. People with such pattern should give more consideration to putting aside a nest-egg or buying good insurance policy. Once saving policy is established those markings are likely to disappear.

Course Of Fate Line:



To determine timing on the fate line look at the crossing head line and the line of the heart. The head line crosses the fate line at age of 30. The heart line crosses the fate line at age of 40. If a fate line begins below the head line the first life success comes before age of 30. If the fate line ends after the head line the culmination of life activity comes after the age of 40.



A **broken** fate line indicates a change of career or a change of direction within existing business. If there are no overlapping lines the change is unexpected and dramatic. Presence of overlapping lines speaks of gradual and planned move into a new direction.



An **island** fate line speaks of obstacles to the career and of struggle to overcome them. An individual must put more energy into the career drive and stay committed to established goals.



A **wavy** fate line speaks lack of commitment to follow an accepted strategy. An individual has a philosophy to try a little bit of everything instead of becoming a specialist in one particular field. People with wavy fate line can be easily influenced.



Branches on a fate line speak about encouragement and failures. Branches from a fate line moving upward are encouragement coming from achieved goals. They add strength to the line. Branches from a fate line moving downward speak about disappointments from failures.



Two **parallel** fate lines speaks of two major interests in life. An individual might be devoted to professional career and political career at the same time. Or this person combines regular job with voluntary work. Presence of this pattern might also indicate very happy and harmonic relationship.
