VB To Delphi Translator

Eagle Research of San Francisco, California, have released a new version of VB2D, for translating Visual Basic projects to Delphi.

The new version can now produce code for Delphi 2, from VB Versions 3.0 or 4.0. It also claims nearly 100% conversion of most database code, automatic replacement of commonly used VBX controls, higher quality output and progress reporting.

VB code using the JET database engine (eg for Access databases) is automatically translated to use Eagle's JETset controls, which connect directly to the JET engine for high performance.

The standard version costs \$150 and the professional version (which includes a copy of JETset, plus enhanced reporting and source code) costs \$450. For details visit http://www.xeaglex.com or call +1 415 495 3136, fax: +1 415 3638.

Wise Up...

The popular Wise installer (apparently this means WIndows Self-installing Executable – don't you just *love* those clever acronyms...) has now been upgraded to version 5. It now has a Windows 95 multilingual Wizard look and feel which claims to be even easier to use. Languages supported are English, German, French, Italian and

Spanish. Wise can install program files, graphics, components, make file associations, edit INI files, edit the Registry, add devices and services plus edit AUTOEXEC.BAT and CONFIG.SYS files. It also does a nice cappucino in case you get thirsty... well, no, not really, but maybe in version 6?

HyperAct of Des Moines, Iowa, has released a public beta of a new tool which enables Web site developers to add keyword searching and an automatic table of contents to their sites. Also included are management tools for Web sites and there are plans for lots more in the final release, planned for November.

Display Corel DRAW! And AutoCAD Drawings

ImageFX have released VectorFX, an exciting new ActiveX control which allows your Delphi 2 applications to display a variety of vector graphics formats. These include: CDR, CGM, DRW, DXF, GEM, PLT, HGL, WGF and WMF. EPS previews can also be displayed.

Over 100 effects can be applied to the display (wipe, diagonals, blind, roll, etc) and the graphics can be re-sized, flipped, cropped, zoomed, rotated and reversed. Printing is also supported.

Fax Plus 2.0

Contemporary Software now have MicroHelp's new version of their fax software available. It incorporates 32-bit ActiveX and VBX controls, plus 16- and 32-bit DLLs, plus a re-distributable Windows 95 printer drivers. Delphi is explicitly supported.

The software can be used to build applications which are able to send and receive faxes from most Class 1, Class 2 and CAS compatible modems. Input file types supported include text, BMP, DCX and PCX, whilst incoming faxes can be stored as BMP, DCX and TIF image formats as well as 'raw' binary files. Fax pages can be reoriented if desired.
