AsyncPro 2.5

TurboPower have been working hard on their flagship comms library for Delphi and C++Builder, adding support for ISDN, RS-845 ports and DTMF touch-tone pads, enhanced fax capabilities, better documentation and more. They have tightened the low-level code to improve performance.

TableBob: Table To Source/HTML Wizard

Bob Swart has just released this new Wizard to generate Delphi source code which will regenerate a Paradox table and optionally copy one or more fields from all the records in another table (which can be Access, Paradox, dBASE, etc) to the newly generated Paradox table. Borland has recently released the latest Entera News (check www.borland.com) and also opened a new newsgroup for Entera discussions, at Borland.Public.Entera (or access it via their website).

NWLib

Devont Software is shipping a new collection of Netware-Aware components for Delphi and C++Builder which allow developers to integrate Netware services into their applications.

In addition to the dozen visual controls which integrate facilities such as user lists, print queue and job management, NDS object browsing and Bindery object management, NWLib also offers over 200 high-level functions which turn complex operations into a single line of code.

The entire Netware API is covered, from obtaining user connection information, all the way up to creating NDS objects and extending the NDS Schema.

NWLib Standard Edition costs \$95 in the USA for Delphi or C++Builder versions. The Enterprise Edition costs \$225 and contains both the Delphi and C++Builder versions plus complete source code, unlimited updates and email technical support. Piparti 3.0

Piparti 3.0 has been redesigned from the ground up to provide an extensible platform for tackling advanced reporting requirements in four key areas: report layout and design, data access, output device support, and dialog customization.

New features allow the design of complex reports without writing code. Free-form subreports provide a simple, powerful solution for

handling multiple master/detail relationships, multiple section reports and side-by-side presentation of data. Precise positioning is available in various units. Both data access and report output are open and extensible. Reports can be previewed, printed and exported. Also included is a forms API which enables the developer to replace any of Piparti's built-in dialogs without changing the source.

Piparti 3.0 and Piparti Pro 3.0 include versions for Delphi 1, 2, and 3, and include full source code. The US price is \$249 for Piparti and \$495 for Piparti Pro (check with your retailer for local pricing).
