Abbrevia 2 Compression

New from TurboPower Software is an enhanced version of its data compression library.

The new version includes support for Microsoft CAB files as well as the ZIP format. New features also include disk spanning for large archives, support for compression to and from a memory stream, new user interface capabilities, better self-extracting archives and more.

In a first for TurboPower, as well as components for all versions of Delphi and C++Builder, COM objects are also included to support other development environments.

ESBMaths 2.0 is a collection of mathematical routines, including integer, floating point, conversions, arrays and vector operations. ESBRoutines 1.4 includes 16- and 32-bit bit lists, block manipulations, conversions, booleans, string manipulations and environment manipulation. ESBDates 1.2 provides date/time routines, including date arithmetic, time arithmetic, conversions, Easter calculation, time zone routines (including RFC822 compliant ones), regional settings and more.

ProDelphi 6.2 Profiler

ProDelphi for Delphi 2, 3 and 4 measures the running time of methods, procedures or functions in CPU cycles. It gives detailed results as well as an overview. A built-in viewer can be used to check the results or they can be exported.

Version 6.2 includes conditional compilation support to add more flexibility in profiling, switching profiling on or off at various points within the code. Threads are also supported.

A Pentium or compatible CPU is required. ProDelphi costs \$50 and

Blaise Compound Components

Blaise Software have released a new set of over 50 Delphi components which are themselves made up of multiple components.

The aim is to reduce the number of components required for a given task and make development easier. Most components include a caption component, for example, some lookup components include a table, query and datasource, other components have push buttons. All components have component editors that allow the user to view and edit properties in one screen, at design-time or runtime.

SpeechKit 2.1

From Chant Inc these components allow developers to add speech recognition and speech synthesis (text-to-speech) capabilities to Delphi applications. Typical applications include filling out forms, querying databases and navigation within applications.

Commands and phrases or continuous dictation are all supported, with management of multiple vocabularies. A built-in

grammar compiler allows creation of dynamic vocabularies on the fly. Chant components support multiple languages and locales.

Addict 2.32 Spell Checker

Addictive Software has released Addict 2.32, the latest version of their Spell Checking Component Suite, for all versions of Delphi.

The product supports live spelling (as in Word 97). The developers claim it mirrors, and in some ways exceeds, the functionality of the spell check engines in several commercial word processors. Addict includes a dictionary compiler that allows you to build your own dictionaries. Multi-user support is included and the language modules allow internationalisation. A thesaurus is also included, along with a thesaurus compiler.
