## Chimney Sweep Your Paradox Files

Chimney Sweep from Sundial Services fixes common Paradox database problems such as *index out of date, corrupt file* etc. The Standard version is a menu-driven standalone utility generating a detailed report on problems encountered and fixes implemented, costing \$60 plus VAT.

The Pro version includes a Delphi/C++Builder component and an ActiveX with full annotated Delphi source code. It uses a well-documented API, provided in the form of 16-bit and 32-bit DLLs (with no source), to execute scripts built with a script editor. The Pro version costs \$225 plus VAT.
