ExpressPrinting System 2.0

Developer Express have a new version of its data presentation and visualisation system for Delphi and C++Builder.

The component-based system is able to render and print visual controls from Developer Express as well as a number of standard VCL controls. In addition to its design-time capabilities, ExpressPrinting System includes runtime designers to help minimise the time you spend developing custom reporting. At runtime, by combining the ExpressPrinting System with the QuantumGrid MasterView and/or controls, end-users can arrange data in any way they like and then print the contents of the control exactly as it appears on-screen.

In version 2, printing support is provided for the following visual controls: ExpressQuantumGrid Suite, ExpressQuantumTreeList, ExpressMasterView, ExpressInspector, ExpressTreeView, ExpressOrgChart, ExpressFlowChart, RichEdit, rxRichEdit, StringGrid, DrawGrid, ListBox and TeeChart.

New features in version 2.0 include improved performance (claimed to be 20 to 50 times faster), complex master-detail reports, full custom draw support, print style components (allowing you or end-users to create and save custom styles), header and footer support, enhanced page

setup and print dialogs, plus intellimouse controlled zoom.

Elysian eUpdator Client Library

New from Elysian Development is a client library for the eUpdator System. The eUpdator System provides applications with automatic version checking and updating through internet or intranet connections. Product updates are put on a central server and eUpdator automatically notifies all clients and updates the software. Since the eUpdator System also works over internet connections it is an easy way to add automatic updates through the internet (in the same way that Windows Update does) for all your distributed software.

The eUpdator System is fully multi-threaded, meaning that all tasks are executed without interrupting your applications. It can download updates while users continue using the application. The client library is available as a native Delphi component and as a DLL for C/C++.

The eUpdator application and the basic client package are both available free, for both commercial and non-commercial applications.

The Client Professional Package costs \$20 and allows you to monitor and control progress using callbacks. You can modify, replace or remove the standard dialogs,

allowing you to translate the client into any language desired. Also included is a sample application for Delphi and the eUpdator Infofile Wizard for creating the required information files.

The Client Developer Package costs \$90 and adds to the Professional Package by including full source for both the standard and professional clients, as well as a licence to distribute the eUpdator application with your own software.

ProKylix 1.2 Source Code Profiler For Kylix

New from the developer of the ProDelphi source code profiler for Delphi, Helmuth Adolph, comes the ProKylix profiler for Kylix: incredibly soon after the release of Kylix! Both ProDelphi and ProKylix are freeware, too.

ProKylix measures the running time of methods, procedures or functions in CPU cycles, giving detailed results and identifying candidate routines for optimisation. Measurement results can be viewed using a built-in viewer, or exported to a database or text file. Results can be viewed as the number of CPU cycles or as time units (the smallest time unit is 0.001 micro-second). A history function enables the user to quickly compare results with previous runs stored in history files.

Coverage profiling is supported on a procedural base. A tree view shows which methods were not called whilst profiling. Measuring pure assembler code is supported in the professional version.

Procedures that have already been optimised can be excluded from profiling by inserting a special comment. ProKylix allows you to switch measuring on and off at procedure entry. An automatic exclusion of procedures with very short runtimes is also possible. Special treatment of Linux API calls such as Sleep as well as the functions like TApplication ProcessMessages and HandleMessage guarantee that no sleeping times are measured and that procedure times are not counted as child times when they are not child times.

ProKylix is delivered as freeware and can be upgraded using a registration key to the Professional Mode. In the Freeware Mode up to 30 procedures can be measured, in the Professional Mode up to 32,000 procedures can be measured. ProKylix can be executed under all Linux versions under which Kylix runs, if the computer has an Intel Pentium processor or compatible (eg AMD K6 or Athlon Duron).

InterBase Clarification

Thanks to Borland's Steve Axtell, we can clarify the situation about InterBase 6.0: is it free, is it commercial? (see last month's News).

There is a commercial product, as detailed last month, which includes all the usual options such as manuals and support. The Open Source version is available in source code and binary form (version 6.01), for platforms including Windows and Linux, at

interbase/opensource/

We understand that these downloads will remain there, but they may not necessarily be updated over time as the commercial version will. The InterBase public licence is based on the Mozilla Public Licence (which means you do not have to distribute the source).

Award For Anders Heilsberg

The author of Turbo/Borland Pascal and the chief architect of Delphi, Danish developer Anders Hejlsberg, has received the *Dr Dobb's Excellence in Programming Award* for 2001.

Turbo Pascal originated in the early 1980s as a command-line Pascal compiler called Compass Pascal, later to become Poly Pascal and to be licensed to Borland. After adding the familiar IDE, Turbo Pascal was born on 20th November, 1983. The rest is history: release from the constraints of

BASIC and the tyranny of C for many thousands of programmers! After completing the last version of Turbo Pascal (7.0), Anders became chief architect of the Delphi project, heralding yet another programming revolution.

In 1996, seeking fresh challenges, Anders moved ship to Microsoft, working on Visual J++, the Windows Foundation Classes and most recently as the chief designer of the C# language and a vital member of the .NET framework team.

Anders truly is a hero amongst developers, and we'd like to add our own warm tribute to that of *Dr Dobb's Journal*. Without his work, many of us would have had far less rewarding development careers.

From Software With Brains, SWBTracker allows developers to track defect reports and change requests for their software products. The product allows users to customise defect classifications, plus organise defects and change requests for any number of products and releases.

Tracking covers a defect's origin, environment, workaround, correction and testing, allowing free-form notes to be entered at each stage of the development cycle. SWBTracker can also automatically notify other users or customers when a new defect is entered, or whenever a defect's status changes. Also featured are user-definable filters and sorting that allow each user to see just the information that is useful to them in a way that is useful to them. Version 6.2 expands the security

system and adds several of the new features.
