Kylix Desktop Price Crash!

Kylix Desktop Developer has been dramatically reduced in price and is now selling at \$139 plus VAT (\$199 in the USA). If you bought that product at the original price, Borland says you are entitled to a free upgrade to the Server Developer edition: contact Customer Services in the UK on 0800 454065.

The price reduction is stated to be until 23 August 2001, but we think it would be a brave company (not to mention foolhardy) that hiked the price back up again on 24 August. Regretfully, the Server Developer edition has not been reduced in price: we hope Borland will see the light on this also.

IT-Map To Launch dbPal

A new database tool called dbPAL is to be launched in July at BorCon in the USA. Developed jointly in the UK and USA using Delphi, dbPAL offers developers a toolkit for database design, conversions and database synchronisation that is universal across most DBMS types.

Build With FinalBuilder

FinalBuilder is designed to automate the software build process, something that developers have traditionally used batch files or general purpose scripting tools for. The developers claim that FinalBuilder allows

automate your builds in a GUI environment, where batch programming skills are not needed.

The product currently supports Delphi (versions 3, 4, 5 and 6), Borland Resource Compiler, Visual Basic 6, Source Safe, Wise Install, InstallShield, Inno Setup and Doc-O-Matic. In addition, the developers claim that many other products are also supported via their command-line interfaces (for example, C++Builder and Visual C++). The product also has action types that send email, FTP files, copy files, move files, delete files, create directories, delete directories, set file attributes, execute programs, run DOS commands and create Zip files.
