for use as a CC file or for implementation via Arexx.

1.2 Installation

Make sure you have Triton version 1.2 or later properly
installed.

Copy the "verteiler" executable anyplace you like. The database defaults to "progdire:verteiler.database", so you might want to

- a) create a directory somewhere, to store both the executable and the database. In this case, you might want to add the new directory to your path. Or you can
- b) always specify the database path and filename using the DATABASE argument.

Once you have arranged all the Windows the way you like them (it always looks a bit messy at first ;-), you could cheat the unregistered Triton preferences by copying env:Triton to envarc:

1.3 Usage

```
Verteiler [DATABASE <file>] [INTO <file>] [PUBSCREEN <name>]
[COMMA] [DEBUG] [RECKLESS] [FOR <list>]
```

Start Verteiler from a shell.

If you don't want "progdire:verteiler.database" as your default database, specify something else using the DATABASE argument.

If you want to create a "cc file"/distribution list, give it's name using INTO.

Verteiler defaults to Workbench. If you want it to pop up somewhere else, specify where by using PUBSCREEN.

Example: verteiler DATABASE=s:data INTO=t:temp PUBSCREEN=ZPoint

When reporting bugs, please use DEBUG to find out where the bug appears. Just send me the output and indicate where the bug showed up. This is especially true for Enforcer hits.

Use RECKLESS to disable the confirmation request. Note that you can no longer create an INTO file without saving the database.

Specifying COMMA will cause Verteiler to start every line but the first one with a " ," blank, then comma. By putting "Cc:" in front of that, you get a valid SMTP Cc: header line.

You can make Verteiler write its INTO file and exit without any user intervention necessary. To do this, supply the distribution you want the INTO file for using the FOR argument.

The argument supplied with FOR is case sensitive.

If the requested list cannot be located, the user will be notified and Verteiler acts as if FOR had not been specified.

Finally, you will see the
Verteiler Window
popping up.

When starting Verteiler with an INTO file, you initially are in the "build a list" mode.

When starting without INTO or after selecting any one of the "edit" functions, you are in "edit" mode.

1.5 Implementation for Zodiac's Point

Start_Verteiler.rexx

Requirements
The current version of this script requires the ZPoint v37.191(15.5.95) or later.
A version for previous ZPoint releases is included, but does not feature the full functionality. (Start_Verteiler_08.zprx)

Installation

Copy this script to the ZPoint rexx directory. Edit the fkeys.zp or usermenus.zp to execute

```
Sys:Rexxc/RX ZPoint:Rexx/Start_Verteiler.zprx %s
```

You might want to edit the settings inside the script, english users might want to set "Sprache" to "english".
Restart ZPoint

Usage

Write the message just as you would for one receiver.
 Then start Start_Verteiler.
 Double Click on the desired list.
 That's it.
 Remember that the message will not only go to the list but
 also to the receiver you gave in the "Send" requester, so
 perhaps you might specify yourself there...

The newest version of Start_Verteiler allows you to specify
 the name of the target verteiler in the receiver box of
 zpoint by inserting "listname@verteiler". If "listname"
 contains blanks or fancy characters, ZPoint might refuse
 to work.

For additional documentation in German, read the file
 Start_Verteiler.rexx itself.

1.6 Implementation for AmigaElm / Aed / Dme

AmigaElm / Aed / Dme

AmigaElm allows to edit the header lines of your mail
 directly in the editor.
 So you can just type "Cc: " under the "To:" line, then
 insert an INTO file created with the COMMA option.

Beware: Some sendmails do not support the so-called
 continuation lines. You'd have to join all the address lines,
 but not more than 1000 chars are allowed. Anyway, in this
 case, you'd better get another sendmail.
 I know SMTPPost from InetUtils to work properly.

For Aed, you can map a key or a menu to execute Verteiler
 by saying something like (of course in one line):

```
map f7 ((Cc: ) ping 9 down execute (verteiler into t:yyvv
comma) insfile t:yyvv execute (delete t:yyvv) pong 9 join)
```

This should work similar if not identical with Dme and its
 various clones.

1.7 Known Bugs

* These bugs are not guaranteed to appear in unmodified form ↔
 in
 future releases :-) *

Verteiler won't open on any other PubScreen but Workbench.

You do have no Triton preferences. Run Triton prefs at least once and answer the questions with "yes", then click "Save". Should vanish with Triton 1.3.

When deleting the last entry, there's no valid current entry. Select one by hand. Should vanish with Triton 1.3.

Elm won't send to anyone but the first CC: line.
You've got a stupid sendmail / SMTPPost. Look
here
.

When using ZPoint, only part of the CC file is used.
That's not true. ZPoint does not always show all ZConnect "To:" lines, even when you save to disk. But looking at the outgoing PUFFER or using the command SAVEMESSAGEASIS will reveal that everything is as intended.

1.10 Verteiler window

This is the main window.

NEW will create a new (empty) distribution list.

EDIT will bring up the
Entry window
MOVE will rename the current list

COPY will add all the entries in the current list to the end of a list with the name "Buffer". If Buffer does not yet exist, it will be created.

KILL will delete a list.

OK will save the database and create the INTO file (if you

requested so)

CANCEL will quit without saving the database and without creating an INTO file.

GATHER ADRESSES will go through the whole database and add every address to a new list called "Everybody".

When starting Verteiler with an INTO file, you initially are in the "build a list" mode. This means that double clicking an entry in the main listview will result in the creation of the INTO file for the clicked group.

When starting without INTO or after selecting any one of the "edit" functions, you are in "edit" mode. Then you have to select OK to create or to not create an INTO file.

1.11 Entry window

This is the window to edit a distribution list.

NEW will add a new entry to the list.

EDIT will edit the name and address of the current entry.

MOVE will copy the current entry to a list called "Buffer". If Buffer does not exist, it will be created. The current entry will then be removed from the current list.

COPY will also copy the current entry to "Buffer", but still leave it in the current one.

KILL will delete an entry.

OK will return to the main window.

KILL DUPES will remove duplicate entries from the list. Note that only entries matching 1:1, including case sensitivity, will be removed.

All changes take place immediately. Since there is no way to cancel or undo, there is no CANCEL gadget.
