You can find diskfont.library in the VMB:Libs directory.

1.17 rexxapp.library

VMB needs the rexxapp.library

rexxapp.library is a PD library

You can find rexxapp.library in the VMB:Libs directory.

1.18 rexxsupport.library

VMB needs the rexxsupport.library version 34.9 or higher

You can find rexxsupport.library in the VMB:Libs directory.

1.19 rexxsyslib.library

VMB need the rexxsyslib.library version 36.23 or higher

You should have this file installed in you LIBS: directory (if the installation hasn't already been done by the Commodore Workbench installation script).

You can find rexxsyslib.library on a Workbench 2.0 (or higher) disk.

1.20 reqtools.library

VMB need the reqtools.library version 38 or higher

MUI is an object oriented system to create and maintain graphical user interfaces. From a programmers point of view, using MUI saves a lot of time and makes life much easier. Thinking about complicated terms like window resizing or font sensitivity is simply not necessary.

On the other hand, users of MUI based applications have the ability to customize nearly every pixel of a programs interface according to their personal taste.
