Information and Features

JoneSoft Icon Extractor extracts all embedded icons from files and allows the user to save extracted icons as icons or bitmaps. JoneSoft Icon Extractor utilises the familiar "Windows Explorer" look and feel for ease of use.

Features:

- Extraction from whole folders with a simple click;
- Ability to include files in sub-folders when extracting;
- Ability to select file types from which to extract;
- Ability to customise toolbar and interface;
- Ability to save as icons or bitmaps in either 16x16 or 32x32 size;
- Full registry clean-up option should you wish to remove the application.



Using Icon Extractor

JoneSoft Icon Extractor is very simple to use. Simply click on the folder containing the files from which you wish to extract icons and JoneSoft Icon Extractor does the rest, adding all icons it extracts into the right viewing pane. The count of icons displayed appears on the status bar after all icons have been retrieved. You can stop extracting at any time by pressing the "Esc" key, or by selecting another folder.

To save or copy an icon or selection of icons, simply highlight the icon(s) and select "Save As" or "Copy" from the toolbar, or from the pop-up menu. Icons can be saved in either 16x16 or 32x32 icon (.ico) or bitmap (.bmp) format in the location of your choice. Selecting "Copy" will copy the icon to the clipboard, allowing you to paste the icon into another application.

NOTE: If you have selected multiple icons and choose "Copy", only the first icon in the selection will be copied to the clipboard.

Shortcut keys: **F1**: display this help file. **F5**: to re-extract from the selected folder. **Esc**: to stop extracting.

Configuring

The interface of JoneSoft Icon Extractor is very similar to that of Windows Explorer, and can be customised in much the same way. In addition to the standard resizing and display abilities, you can configure the way the program works through the configuration option. Selecting "Configuration" from the "View" menu allows you to do this by providing the following options.

General Tab

Toolbar

<u>Show button text</u>: If selected, labels will appear under the toolbar images. Default is On. <u>Show tool tips</u>: If selected, tool tips will appear when the mouse passes over a tool bar button. Default is On.

<u>Images always coloured</u>: If selected, toolbar images remain coloured, whether they have focus or not. Default is Off.

Miscellaneous

<u>Include files in sub-folders when extracting</u>: If selected, JoneSoft Icon Extractor will include all files in the selected folder's sub-folders when extracting. Default is Off. <u>Remove all entries from the system registry...</u>: If selected, this option will remove all entries from the system registry for this application when it is next exited. Use this option when removing this application, or if you wish to reset all values back to the original default. Default is Off.

Advanced Tab

Extract Icons from

<u>All file types</u>: If selected, JoneSoft Icon Extractor attempts to extract icons from all file types. Default option.

<u>These file types only</u>: This option allows you to choose specific file types from which to extract, thus speeding up the extraction process. To extract only from certain file types, select this option and type the file extensions, beginning with a period (.) and excluding spaces, into the file type input box. JoneSoft Icon Extractor will ignore any files that do not have one of these file extensions.
