

Below is example commands you can send to your mailer from a remote email client, telling the system to complete some tasks at home and to send you needed information.

Note that all red words are just examples that you would exchange with your own commands. All green words are the commands themselves.

### **Begin Commands**

Password must be accessible for the Interpreter. This is for your data security:

**PassWord** xxxx

Below we start a dos command block. Any dos commands at all except FORMAT and DELTREE. Those two commands will NOT be executed.....

The DIR is just an example to show the usage of the command block:

### **Begin Dos Commands**

```
dir c:\windows > winlist.dir  
dir c:\windows\command >> winlist.dir
```

### **End Dos Commands**

Next command sends a new message to the given receiver with two files attached:

**Send New message to** xxx@ccc **attach** winlist.dir **attach** example.doc

This command sends the last x messages as-is to the given receiver:

**Send Last** 0 **to** xxx@ccc
