How To Install for Windows® 95

If you have Windows 95 already installed on your computer, installation is a snap. We've included Auto Play as a feature of our disc for Windows 95 users.

- 1. Insert *The Guided Tour of Multimedia* disc into your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Disc will automatically begin installation procedure if it has not been installed before.
- 3. Follow the instructions on the screen.
- 4. If you have already installed the *The Guided Tour of Multimedia* disc previously, it will automatically launch into the program for you.

How To Install for Windows® 3.1

Let's install:

We'll assume that you're slightly acquainted with Windows. If not, please refer to your Windows user guide to clarify these standard steps.

- 1. Start your computer and go to the Windows **Program Manager**.
- Put your new The Guided Tour of Multimedia CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.
- Open the File menu, then choose Run.
- 4. Type the following: [drive]\setup where [drive] is replaced by the letter for your CD-ROM drive. For example, if "d" is the letter for your CD-ROM drive, you would type: d:\setup and then press the Enter key.
- 5. Follow the instructions that appear on your screen.

Everything needed to run *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition* will install automatically on your hard drive or is contained on the CD-ROM itself. You'll see a new **Group Window** called *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition* on your screen. Double-click *The Guided Tour of Multimedia* Group icon to access the *Guided Tour* program icon and a **Read Me** icon.

Tip: Double-click on the **Read Me** icon to get the latest installation, technical and other information.

How to Start *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition:* Double-click on the *Guided Tour* icon in the **Group Window** called *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition*.

Electronic Registration:

- We've made it fast and easy for you to register your CD-ROM. It's called E-Reg (for Electronic Registration) and you'll see it on screen right after you install *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition*.

TIPS: If you see the error message **"Invalid TrueType Font Detected"** when you startup *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition,* do the following:

- 1. Choose **Close**, then press and hold down the **Alt** key while pressing the **F4** function key. You will now be in Windows' Program Manager.
- Open the Main group window and double-click on the ATM Control Panel icon to open the Adobe Type Manager window.
- 3. You will see ATM and On/Off buttons on the left side of the window. Click the **Off** button to turn the Adobe Type Manager off.
- **4.** Close Adobe Type Manager and restart Windows. *The Guided Tour of Multimedia*, *2nd Edition* should now work properly.

When you are finished with *The Guided Tour of Multimedia, 2nd Edition*, repeat steps 2 - 4 (except that you will click the **On** button in step 3) to return to your normal Windows environment.
