Read this file before installing SoftPC

The installation procedure for SoftPC is relatively simple. The first thing to do is to read this file thoroughly (print it if necessary). SoftPC consists of two file packages, one on each release disk. The first disk contains the necessary files to run SoftPC, and the second disk contains the SoftPC manual.

1) Put the first installation disk into your floppy drive, and look at it in the File Viewer. There are three files on the disk: this readme file, softpc.pkg and a file called bios2.rom. Double-click on the softpc.pkg file. This will make the NeXT Installer install the package on to your hard disk. SoftPC will by default install in the Apps directory in your home directory, but this can be over-ridden in the Installer.

2) When the installation is complete, open the created SoftPC.app folder (which will be in ~/Apps, unless you over-rode the default location), and copy the bios2.rom file into it from the first installation floppy.

3) Eject the first installation floppy. If you do not want the SoftPC manual on line, then you need not install from the second floppy at all and can skip this step. Otherwise, put in the second installation floppy. You will see in the File Viewer that there are two files on the disk: this readme file and manual.pkg. Double-click on the

manual.pkg file to make the NeXT Installer install the package on the hard disk. The manual will by default install in ~/Apps/SoftPC.app. If you over-rode the location for the SoftPC package then you must over-ride the location for the manual so that it is installed in the SoftPC.app folder.
