Dots is a generic printer driver which allows you to connect different printers to your NeXT computer. Dots supports impact dot-matrix printers, ink-jet printers, non-PostScript laser printers and Canon CLC color laser copiers. Printers that are connected with Dots are available throughout the network.

Dots is available in 3 different versions:

Dots 2.0 supports impact dot-matrix printers, ink-jet-printers and non-PostScript laser printers which are connected to your NeXT computer through the serial port or another interface:

- · Epson 24-pin dot-matrix printer and compatibles (up to 360 x 180 dpi)
- · NEC 24-pin do-matrix printer and kompatible (up to 360 dpi)
- · IBM Proprinter XL AGM compatible printers (up to 360 dpi)
- · HP LaserJet compatible printers (up to 300 dpi)
- · HP DeskJet compatible printers (up to 300 dpi)
- · Canon BJ-300 compatible printers (up to 360 dpi)

Dots 2.0 Color can print on the same printers as Dots 2.0, but also supports the HP Deskjet 500 C, a low-cost three-color ink-jet printer that makes printing in color affordable enough for it to be available on every desk.

Dots CLC supports the line of Canon Color Laser Copiers with a resolution of 400 dpi. A PostScript IPU is not required. Dots uses the SCSI port of the non-PostScript IPU-10, which is relatively inexpensive. The following models are supported:
