

Introduction

This manual shows you how to use the ENlighten/DSM's features. This includes executing the Sys Admin features, creating and modifying the Events tests, and using the Status Map as a visual aid in tracking and fixing system and network issues.

The Sys Admin features comprise all of the graphical user interface (GUI) options except the Events and Status Map menus.

The main program components and their basic functions are:

- **Configure** set up ENlighten/DSM configuration, network pools, and program parameters.
- **Security** perform security checks on the system; check for obvious passwords.
- **User** configure user accounts and user groups; manage processes; check user security.
- **Disk** observe disk utilization by groups, users, and file systems; search for files; configure NFS file systems.

- Archive configure archive devices; backup and restore files; schedule backups.
- Printer configure local and remote printers; enable and disable printers; manage print queues.
- System manage cron jobs; set system clocks; manage mail aliases; observe swap space usage and more.
- Network configure and manage networks, host entries, and DNS, NIS, and NIS+ servers.
- Events configure Events parameters.
- Navigate enable and/or use the Status Map GUI.

The rest of the chapters in this manual detail how each of the ENlighten/DSM menu options works. Each main menu and its menu items are described in its own chapter.

To configure Events (test) parameters, refer to the *ENlighten/DSM User Guide*. To use the Status Map, see [Chapter 11, "Navigate."](#) For general details on how to install your package, navigate in the GUI, or use the PEP processor, see the *ENlighten/DSM User Guide*.
