1.1 ppACCESSORY.Guide

What is ppACCESSORY ?

Well basically it is an AMOS Professional accessory which will allow you to crunch and decrunch your source code including any memory banks that might be attached to them.

1.2 How to install your copy of ppACCESSORY

Make sure that you consult your USER GUIDE on how to install accessory programs within AMOS Professional as there are a few ways to do it.

1.3 How to use ppACCESSORY

Using ppACCESSORY is very simple now that I have combined both ppSAVE and ppLOAD into one accessory that has a GUI (Graphical User Interface) which makes it much more user friendly. Just point and click on the appropriate

button to crunch and save your current program, decrunch and load in a previously crunched program, or exit from the accessory all together. I have also included the following keyboard shortcuts:

- Press[S] to Crunch and Save your source code.
- Press[L] to Decrunch and Load your source code.
- Press[0-4] to set the crunching effeciency.
- Press[ESC] to Exit. You can also press the [ESC] key to abort any requesters that have buttons on them.

After selecting the crunch or decrunch button a file requester will appear and at that point you can enter in the appropriate filename, making sure that it ends with the extension ".ppAMOS". Then ppACCESSORY will do it's thing. Selecting the exit button will return you to the EDITOR.

Before attempting to crunch your source code, ppACCESSORY will scan the Editor for a program. If nothing is found, a requester will drop down stating so and will abort the crunching process.

1.4 How to change PowerPacker's effeciency.

Simple ... just click on the buttons labeled 0-4. The default setting is set at 0.

What does all those numbers mean ?

- 0 = Fast
- 1 = Mediocre
- 2 = Good
- 3 = Very Good
- 4 = Best

NOTE: When setting the effeciency to 4, the crunching process will be ~~~~~ very slow.

1.5 History of ppACCESSORY

This is the current history of ppACCESSORY:

1.0b - The very first public release.

- Combined both ppSAVE and ppLOAD into one accessory.
- No longer requires the CLI commands CRUNCH and DECRUNCH.
- Documentation in AmigaGuide format.

1.2 - Added program auto-detection routine.

- 1.3 Made major improvements in the crunch and decrunch routines. Since I have re-written them, ppACCESSORY is about 6k shorter than before.
 - Removed the LED flash during the crunching process.
- 1.4 Added the ability to change PowerPacker's crunching effeciency.

- Removed a few bugs.
