EZ-Address v1.2e by: Johnny Ow, Alley Cat Productions

Shareware:

First of all, this is a shareware program, and as such you are free to test it out for a period of 30 days. If at the end of that time you find this program useful, then you should send \$10 to the author. With registration, you will receive the next release of EZ-Address when it becomes available.

You are free to distribute the unregistered version of EZ-Address with all the files as long as no fee is charged for the program itself.

What is needed:

An appropriate IBM or compatible computer running **Windows v3.x**, and the Visual BASIC run time library **VBRUN100.DLL** which is available on most BBS's.

Getting Started:

Just copy EZADDRES.EXE to your main window's directory and add it to your Windows accessories program group using the **new file** comand in **Program Manager**.

Note that EZ-Address creates an entry in your WIN.INI file for itself under the heading [EZ-Address]. Should you decide that you do not want this program, remember to remove this section from the WIN.INI file when you delete the program files.

About the program:

Simply put, this is a VERY easy-to-use electronic address book. Currently it can handle 154 records. Most of the functions are self-explantory, but let me explain a couple of things.

On the main form, there are 2 numbers at the bottom right hand corner. The first number indicates what record you are on, and the second number indicates the total number of records in your address book. All records are saved automatically when you exit the program.

To perform a Find Next operation, simply click on the **FIND**... button and then press <ENTER> or click on the OK button without changing the search string.

Generally, if you click on one of the Quick Index buttons at the bottom of the form you will be shown the first record with a Last Name which begins with the letter you clicked on. If no records begin with the letter, then you will be shown the first record **after** the selected letter.

To use the phone dialing option, you must have a modem and tell EZ-ADDRESS where it is located by clicking on the **Config...** button the first time you use it (your settings will be saved). Now to dial, simply click on the button above the number you want to dial. Note, to make the modem pause while dialing, insert a comma in the prefix or telephone number.

Also, the comment field currently holds 2 1/2 lines of text.
