

Displays the name of the user who is currently logged in to this node.

Displays the location of the user who is currently online on this node.

Displays the handle of the user who is currently online on this node.

Displays roughly the activity of the user who is currently online on this node.

Displays the attributes this user has.

-'Hidden' indicates if the user is hidden from the userlist.


-'Wants chat' indicates if the user wants to chat.


-'Do not disturb' indicates if the user is available of multiline messages.

-'Ready/Busy' indicates wether or not the node is used.

-'New user' indicates that the user is making his first call.

Displays the users who have called to this node today.

 indicates that the user is a new user.

 indicates that the user is a normal user.

Click on one of the columns to sort users.

Number of calls today, made to this node.

Each node had its own tab. If you click on a tab, you see the specific information on this node.

What is it?

- The StatusMonitor is a tool especially for the sysop who run their BBS under Windows95. Now you don't need to have your BBS opened in a small Window anymore to look who is online. Just leave it in the TaskBar. StatusMonitor will give you all the information you need. Not just who is online (or lines because StatusMonitor automatically detects multinode systems), but also a summary of things, like the callers to one or all nodes today, Total callers, status of the user, etc., etc.

Troubleshooting

The most asked questions and problems are mentioned on this page

The StatusMonitor finds more nodes than I actually have

- TC Statusmonitor calculates the number of nodes by looking to the size of the file USERON.BBS and deviding it by a certain number. If the size of that file is to large, the StatusMonitor will find more nodes than really are available. Make sure that there is no user online on the node(s) and delete the file USERON.BBS. Wait until a caller logs in (or make a local logon) and the problem will be solved.

Why did the message 'Wrong version of runtime DLL' appear?

- Earlier versions of TC were compiled with outdated libraries. The setup program just wouldn't install the DLL files because newer versions were already installed. Versions 1.0 and higher are compiled with new runtimes, so this problem belongs to the past...

Why are those 2 buttons removed?

- The buttons are not removed. Probably you run a single node system so the buttons wouldn't work anyway, so they are only visible if you run a multinode system.

Do you have a problem with the StatusMonitor? Please let me know, your question (and answer) may help others.

Online Help

TC StatusMonitor supports the Windows95 standard context-sensitive help

How does it work?

- TotalControl and StatusMonitor support the Windows95 help system. This means that if you want to know anything about the program, you can click with your right mouse button on the item you want information about and a popup menu appears. This popup menu will most of the time give you one option: 'What's this'. If you select this option, a nice popup window appears which explains the function of the item you clicked on.

Lets the current node exit with an errorlevel.
Click with right mouse button and select 'Errorlevel:' to change errorlevel.

Displays the user's connection speed.

Hides local logins from all lists

Write a note to the user on this node.

This button reminds you to register Totalcontrol!
See ORDER.TXT for registration information.

Shows a notify window when a user wants to chat with you.

This list shows an overview of all your nodes, it gives your information about the current activities, number of calls to a node, and the share of a node in all calls.
