



Tagger 4.0 Installation Instructions

There are two ways to install Tagger. You can run a macro that automatically installs Tagger, or you can install the program manually.

1 How do I install Tagger automatically?

To run a macro that automatically installs Tagger, simply

2 How do I install Tagger manually?

A. Uninstall any previous version of Tagger: If you have used a previous version of Tagger, you should remove the old macros and toolbar from your system like this:

1. From the "Tools" menu, choose "Macro ...".
2. Click the "Organizer" button to display the Organizer dialog box. You should see TAGGER40.DOT displayed in the left window and your default template (usually NORMAL.DOT) displayed in the right window.
3. Below the left window (the window containing TAGGER40.DOT), click the "Close File" button.
4. In the row of tabs along the top of the window, click the "Macros" tab.
5. In the right window, highlight all the macros whose names begin with "Tagger". These may include "Tagger", "TaggerRepeat", and/or "TaggerInstall".
6. Click the "Delete" button to remove the macros from your default template.
7. In the row of tabs along the top of the window, click the "Toolbars" tab.
8. Highlight "Tagger" in the right window.
9. Click the "Delete" button to delete the Tagger toolbar from your default template.
10. Click the "Close" button.

B. Manually install Tagger 4.0:

1. Place a copy of the file TAGGER40.DOT in your Word Startup directory. To determine which directory is the Startup directory, choose Tools/Options and click the "File Locations" tab.
2. Restart Word.

3. If the Tagger toolbar is not visible, activate it by choosing View/Toolbars and selecting the checkbox next to the Tagger entry.
4. Open a document and press the “Tagger” button on the Tagger toolbar.

That's all there is to it!

3 How do I buy a copy of Tagger?

Purchasing Tagger licenses is easier than ever. Simply follow these instructions:

1. Run Tagger and press the “About...” button in the main dialog box.
2. Read the license agreement.
3. Press the “Click here to register Tagger!” button, which runs a special program called “Register” that includes complete purchasing instructions.
4. Follow the instructions to pay for your copy of Tagger by credit card, check, money order, First Virtual, or even cash. If you are specifying a purchase for your business, the program can also print an invoice containing instructions for your company’s purchasing department.

4 How do I use Tagger with languages other than “English (US)”?

Support for multiple languages is completely transparent. The program will run without modification in all supported languages; however, all buttons, dialog boxes, and error messages will still be displayed in English.

Thanks to the efforts of a clever Tagger user, and some help from Tagger users in many countries, Tagger is *multi-lingual*. **Ulrich Faehse** wrote a subroutine that translates certain macro keywords into other languages, and Tagger has been structured to use this technique. Here is the list of languages that are now supported by Tagger:

- Danish
- Dutch
- English
- German
- French
- Finnish
- Polish
- Swedish

Do you need to use Tagger in a language other than those listed above? Tagger’s language support is general enough that any language can be incorporated. For details, send e-mail to the author (Tagger@kagi.com).

5 How do I uninstall Tagger 4.0?

Note: Uninstalling Tagger will not affect existing documents.

1. Delete the file TAGGER40.DOT from your Word Startup folder. To determine which folder is the Startup folder, choose Tools/Options and click the "File Locations" tab.
2. Delete the file TAGGER.INI from your Windows directory.
3. Delete the remaining Tagger files, which are usually placed in a folder within the Microsoft Word folder.
4. Restart Word.
