Ted's Female Voiced Potpourri WAVs

Thanks for downloading **Ted's Female Voiced Potpourri WAVs**. There's a "potpourri" of eight .wavs in this archive, designed to be used as sound events in Windows. You'll find some pretty generic stuff here, such as open sounds for any address book, virus scanner, text editor, e-mail program, and icon editor. Also included is "Right!" "You've got spam!" (pefect to replace the "You've got mail" sound for America Online subscribers) and "Explore."

These .wavs can be used in Windows 3.1 and Windows 95. Windows 95 has a better built-in sound hooking system than Windows 3.1 (Win95 users should check out Greg Jones *Sound Events Editor* and *Wave Events* for expanding Windows 95's Control Panel sound hooks), so if you're using Win 3.1, you might want to use a third-party sound hooking utility to expand your system sound events. (I use Aristosoft's *Wired For Sound Pro*, but there are other commercial and shareware utilities that can do this like *Whoop It Up*, *KABOOM!* and *Icon Hear-It* 95.)

All of these sound files are original creations. They were assembled with the excellent shareware WAV editor *Cool Edit 96* from Syntrillium Software. Levels were normalized to give consistent playback volume, EQ was added, and each sound was expertly edited.

These sounds are freely distributed for personal, non-commercial use. Companies or software authors who wish to license these sounds for commercial use should contact the author for more information. I'm also available for custom sound creation for interested software developers.

I hope you enjoy Ted's Female Voiced Potpourri WAVs!
