

## \$1#2K3INT xx Search Keys

This compilation of the Interrupt List has only a short version of interrupt search keys. One reason to reduce the number of search keys is that WinHelp v. 4.00 (coming with Windows 95) has a limited keyword capacity.

The following table lists examples of the unavailable long search key format and corresponding short key format:

| <b>Instead of the long key:</b> | <b>Use the short key:</b> |
