File Manager Jr. (“the Software”) is a shareware product protected by copyright. Your use of the product will constitute acceptance of the terms set out below and will create a legal agreement between you and the author of the Software.

1. Trial Period. You may use the Software without obligation for 30 days. If you continue to use it after the 30-day trial period, you must pay a registration fee. See the file READ_1ST.TXT.

2. License. Registering the Software gives you a license to use the product for as long as you wish. If you use two or more computers, you may install the Software on each of them. Registered users are entitled to support and to discounts on updated versions of the Software. See the file READ_1ST.TXT.

In the absence of a site license, each regular user of the Software is required to have an individual license. A regular user is one who continues to use the Software after a 30-day trial period.

3. Copyright. The author’s title in the Software is protected by U.S. copyright laws. Just as you may not make and sell copies of a book protected by copyright, you may not make and sell copies of the Software.

4. Limited Warranty. The author warrants that File Manager Jr. will perform substantially as described in the accompanying documentation for 90 days from the date of registration. If the program fails to perform as warranted, the author’s only obligation will be to refund the purchase price or, at his option, to repair the Software.
