INSTALLATION

If you received NoiseKiller on diskette:

1. Insert the NoiseKiller diskette into a drive. View its content with the File Manager and double-click INSTALL.EXE.
2. Optionally, modify the installation directory proposed and press the Install button. NoiseKiller will be installed in the directory chosen.

If you received NoiseKiller in a zip file (NK13.ZIP):

1. Unzip the zip file into either a temporary directory or onto a diskette. View its content with the File Manager and double-click INSTALL.EXE.
2. Optionally, modify the installation directory proposed and press the Install button. NoiseKiller will be installed in the directory chosen.
3. If you used a temporary directory you should copy that directory onto a diskette in case you need to reinstall NoiseKiller in the future. You will then be able to delete the temporary directory.

UNINSTALLATION

1. Delete NoiseKiller icons and group in the Program Manager
2. Delete the installation directory in the File Manager

SHAREWARE
