WWW Publisher Standard Options

Use System Browser / Specify External Browser

The system browser is the default browser for HTML Files. To use a browser other than the default, choose "Specify External Browser" and enter the path to the browser.

Size of the MRU List

Sets the number of most recently files whose names are saved on the File menu.

Use Lowercase HTML Tags

Tells WWW Publisher to insert HTML tags in lowercase. If this is unchecked, tags are inserted in uppercase.

Start at Blank File

Tells WWW Publisher to open a blank file on start up.

Show "User Tags" Menu

Tells WWW Publisher to display the user tags menu on the menu bar.

Use HTML Background color

Tells WWW Publisher to change the editor window's color to match any changes in the HTML background

Use Internet Explorer for Internal Browser (Requires IE 4.0)

Tells WWW Publisher to use IE 4.0 ActiveX control for viewing HTML.

WWW Publisher FTP Options

In this dialog you can enter your information for FTP uploads. Enter the Host, Username, and Password.
