New in Kentrol 4.3

In keeping with the principle of building on your strengths, Kentrol 4.3 offers even more tuning options and enhancements.

First and foremost, the **Fine Tuning Step is now user-selectable** from the Options menu.

The default step continues to be 10 Hz, with 1 Hz available with 50-series rigs.

Two new steps have been added, available to everybody: 100 and 500 Hz.

The 100 Hz step is wide enough to cover a band segment quickly and narrow enough to hit most signals dead on. The 500 Hz step extends the coarse tuning range just enough to make most signals audible as you tune by.

Your selected step is saved between sessions and can be over-ridden during a session.

In **CW** or **FSK** modes, the default Autoscroll step is now 500 Hz. And if you have selected 100 Hz as your fine tuning step, Kentrol will use that instead.

And all the quirks, wobbles and bugs that folks have been good enough to report have been tracked down and exterminated.
