

System Administration Release Notes: An Introduction

With every release of its software, NeXT provides notes containing information pertaining to the release. These notes apply to Releases 4.0 and 3.3, and in some cases to earlier releases as well. For additional information, see the *Release Notes* book shipped with the software.

These on-line Release Notes list new features for the system administration of OPENSTEP™ for Mach. They also list problems you might encounter while setting up and maintaining an OPENSTEP network.
