Filename	Comands	Size	Description
aback406.lha	VX	80K	ABackup 4.03 by Denis Gounelle - This ABackup is a backup program. It may be used both to make a backup of your hard disk or to archive files, handles non-AmigaDOS partitions, has a full Intuition interface, and can use XPK library.
barc11b.lha	VX	20K	BackARC V1.1 BETA by Stephen Bradley - This was created for the same reason printer spools were created: to alleviate some extraneous activities for people who are extremely impatient. BackARC is a program designed to sit in the background and unpack files.
dred2310.lha	VX	84K	DRED v1.110 by Bob Rye and Marcus Mroczkowski - DRED stands for Disk REDucer, it's a utility that can save you a lot of disks. It does this is by making a list of files that you want to put onto a number of floppy disks, and working out what files should go where in order to minimize the number of disks needed.
fill-1_1.lha	VX	21K	Fill Version 1.1 by Barry Wills - This is a Smart Multi-file Mover/Copier, it Moves/copies files from the specified directory to a specified destination. Optimizes space on destination by using a "best-fit" algorithm. Capable of filling every byte on a floppy without splitting files. Can accommodate MS-DOS 720k floppies as destination.
mrback15.lha	VX	312K	MRBackup 1.15 by Mark Richard Rinfret - This is a hard disk backup program. It provides a wide range of services to support Amiga file management and backup/restore of files to/from hard disk.
stow07b.lha	VX	20K	Stow 0.7B by Leonard D Atkinson II - This looks at files in a directory and then

attempts to copy them to floppies while wasting as little space as possible. It doesn't pack them perfectly, but it does a pretty good job most of the time.
